These are the minutes of the 171st AMCC meeting held at the Admiral's Inn on Saturday, 10/20/12, in conjunction with the Harbor Masters' 30^{th} Anniversary "Sail Away" " run weekend in Ogunquit, Maine.

CALL TO ORDER

President Steven James called the meeting to order at 1:07 p.m.

ROLL CALL

MINUTES

A proposal to accept the Minutes of the 170th meeting was moved by Long Island Ravens MC, 2nd by Twilight Guard - **motion passed**.

OFFICERS' REPORTS

Secretary's report: The Secretary distributed minutes of the previous meeting and the updated contact sheet to Council members in attendance. Letters to Highwaymen TNT and Potomac MC will be sent requiring representation at the 173^{rd} meeting (according to Article VI-F of the Articles of Agreement) or risk loss of voting privileges. Ballots containing those members nominated for AMCC Office for the 2013-2015 term will be sent to all voting member Clubs.

Treasurer's report: The Treasurer indicated as of 9/30/12, Council had a cash balance of \$2,004.06 (It was noted this amount is not inclusive of proceeds from All-Club AMCC barnight). Treasurer has 30 AMCC patches for sale for \$3.00 each. Treasurer asked for photocopy of driver's license from all those nominated for an office for the 2013-2015 term.

Vice President's report: Thanked all for their participation/assistance with the all-AMCC barnight (See additional items under Outreach committee below).

President's report: Thanked the Harbor Masters for being our hosts and a wonderful weekend. The passing of Brad Lee Hall (past AMCC Officer) was honored with a moment of remembrance. A reminder to all to stay in touch with each other was mentioned.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Outreach Committee:

- The all AMCC barnight held on 8/11/12 at the DC Eagle in Washington DC netted a profit of \$401 (\$902 \$100 expenses and \$401 went to local AMCC Clubs for disbursement).
- Committee will be following up/speaking with a number of clubs that have expressed interest in joining AMCC Both the Keystone and New Jersey boys of Leather and the Bay State Marauders.
- "M is for Motorcycle" campaign is under way. All Clubs were encouraged to include a motorcycle event at their event/bar nights assistance was offered to anyone needing help organizing one.

Historian's Committee: Chairman informed everyone a new person would be appointed to this role at next meeting of Council.
