Discovering Empire City MC was a fortuitous accident for Gary. In 2012, Gary was a volunteer at New York City's "Folsom Street East" and it happened to be the same year that Empire City set up their own booth for the first time ever. Gary spotted ECMC and spoke to a few members. One week later, Gary came up to New York City once again to ride in the Stonewall Pride March – Evil Ed had spotted him in the crowd and asked him to ride with ECMC as a guest. Gary was excited, not only because he'd be riding near the front of the parade, but this was



to be the first gay pride march he'd ever been in!



Gary was an officer (Treasurer) of the Philadelphians MC, a gay men's leather social club in Gary's home city of Philadelphia. When Gary had joined the Philadelphians, only two members rode motorcycle in the organisation – and sadly, once Gary had became a member, those two riders left, leaving Gary alone as the only riding member of the Philadelphians. Motorcycling is very near and dear to Gary, so he became an Associate Member of ECMC October 2012 and only a mere twelve months later, he applied to be our first out-of-town Full Member. At the time, we had recently changed out bylaws allowing an Associate Member who could perform the duties of a Full Member for a full year apply for Full Membership even though they are outside the allowable radius for being a Full Member. In January 2014, Gary was voted in following his mandatory pledge period.



the brothers of ECMC are some of the closest people in his life at this time and he's very appreciative! Gary is thrilled to be involved with other men that have a strong interest in riding motorcycles as he does.



In addition to ECMC, Gary is also associated with other men's groups, including being an associate member of Philadelphians MC, the Keystone Boys of Leather (which is now defunct), M.A.U.L. (The Mid-Atlantic Uniform League), a summer position with the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary and recently a coach of gay volleyball team in the Stonewall Philadelphia Sports League (whom took its name from the historic New York City Stonewall Inn.) Gary met the members of M.A.U.L. at the Raven in New Hope, PA following the 2014 ECMC Biker's Picnic and has been a member since January 2015.

Gary's favourite ride (to date) was an interesting ride involving planes, trains and automobiles – he was a passenger in a side car of a friend's motorcycle, hopped on a bus from there to the airport to Oakland, CA and then

the BART to Modesto, CA where he rented a H-D Electroglide and rode to nearly the Oregon border and back again. A total of 1,400 miles.

His "dream ride" would be ride his motorcycle to Maine, ferry over to Nova Scotia, drive across Nova Scotia, ferry to Newfoundland and ride to St John's to the site of the titanic survivors' location.
