
ECMC IN THE HAMPTONS - (SEPTEMBER 10-11, 2016)

Fast-forward to today and we're happy to say there hasn't been an HIV+ child brought into the "Specialized Foster Care Program" in over six years, but although they are your average run-of-the-mill orphans now, they still need a helping hand to make their holidays special, so ECMC is still there collecting toys year after year! Deborah from Leake and Watts is always at our event, so if you had any further questions, might I suggest you ask her in person – she's a wonderful soul.
