



ECMC's Motorcycle Weekend

The 9th Annual Empire City Motorcycle Weekend in the Fingerlakes Region is still on at this time! We refuse that this will ever be "the new normal" and once the virus has run its course, things will begin returning to normal. We sincerely hope that by the end of May (when our trip is planned), it will be safe.

We are accepting applications presently and the application is on the last page of this newsletter. There is tiered pricing, based on when you submit your application – so get your application in quickly to avoid the price increase or finding the event being sold out! We have room for only 20 people and we have sold out in the past!

We are only accepting cheques or money orders this year, as we have a fail-safe seven days before the

event starts – if for any reason we consider the weekend to be a hazard to anyone's health, we will cancel the event and mail you back (or destroy) your cheque. If the event remains in place, we will deposit the cheques on Monday, 18th May 2020 and there will be no refunds at that point as we will need to shop for all the food and drinks.

Arktos Bears Run Announced


