



I hope everyone is well. We are now into April and have finished our Anniversary Dinner and Food Drive.





FROM THE BACK ROW (Written by Terry T)

Provided by John T and Scott L It comes as a surprise to many new members that their freshly sewn-on colours do not give them access to 100 new friends. It would seem at times that it is easier to make friends with an out-of-town member when you're away from Toronto on a trip than it is with all the sixty or seventy in-town members. Why?

The comraderie of the club scene is frequently touted as one of the major benefits of "belonging." In a small group it is easier to see your fellow members as brothers, comrades, friends. But in a larger organization, friendship does not necessarily accompany acceptance as a member. No one could be expected to necessarily 'like' all one hundred or so members, let alone develope a close friendship with 'em all.

At the same time, those of us who have been on the scene for a number of years have a responsibility to welcome newcomers. In this, we frequently fall down. How many times have you heard - or perhaps said - "He wouldn't have gotten in if I'd had anything to do with it!"

Keep in mind that sixteen of your peers did have something to do with it. While not all sixteen might agree on the prospective member, the majority must before he is accepted.

I certainly don't consider every Spearhead member a close friend, nor do I necessarily 'like' every member. But somewhere along the line each of us was evaluated as to suitability for membership by five members in good standing, the Membership Committee, and finally the Board. I must respect their judgement.

We are, in a sense, a family. And I must confess that there are some members of my real family that I don't even like. Then again, I guess the feeling's mutual.

The Price of Brotherhood

The Main Question

Just what does Brotherhood cost? It seems that there are members who are wondering just where does my renewal fee go? And what am I getting out of it for myself?

Privileges

First of all, let's compare our annual fee to annual fees of Auto Clubs, Shopping Clubs, Credit Cards etc. What does one get from these particular 'Memberships'? One thing is the security of belonging to something that one may need to use at some time. The second thing is the privilege of using the club's services. In most cases, the fee far exceeds what the member is going to derive from the club unless they partake of the services.

If you are looking for a dollar value for the membership fee, check the discounts that members derive from our events.

The main event (and most costly) is the Run. This year, members have the option of paying their Run fee in advance (starting at \$165) and saving up to \$35 on the total if paid before April 30th. A non-member's advance booking starts at \$200, maximum \$225. The annual Spearhead Christmas party usually costs approximately \$1000 to run but it is free to members (based on that price, the cost per member is approximately \$15 each). The Board has tried to put a larger spread on the prices for events between members and non-members so that the members are getting a better value for their membership dollar.


Reality Costs

Due to the wicked ways of the real world, Spearhead has had to take out insurance. This costs about \$2900 per year, which represents approximately 60% or \$42 of every renewal (based on 70 renewals). We have insurance for the very same reason that you buy car insurance...to make sure our butts are covered if an accident should occur at any of our events. We are billed just after renewal time, thus the bank account looks really good for only a couple of weeks. Speaking of the bank account, it of course fluctuates a few times a year-during renewal time, the Anniversary dinner and the Run. After insurance, the balance of the renewal fee is used for administration and paying for event expenses up front (bar nights, deposit on the Run site, rental of helium tanks for balloons, etc.) As for administration, we have to buy stationary, postage, ink cartridges for printers, as well as pay for the maintenance of our bank account.

A Much Bigger Question

Now, why do we pay to belong to such a club?... And we work at all of the events too? Some may think we're crazy but we know better. We do it to belong to a brotherhood of






team workers, to belong to an organization that we're proud of. In effect, we've created our own family. We have our camaraderie as well as our rivalries...just like most families. Spearhead, as a whole, has gained the respect of the community and we all enjoy the security that we share.

A very brief synopsis

The renewal fee is divided by administration costs; insurance \$60%, upfront event expenses for 40%. It is up to the individual member to take advantage of the discounts given at each event if they are looking for the dollar value of their membership. In actuality, Spearhead needs the renewal fee as well as the profits from bar nights to exist.

(** Director of Publications' note....There are other/additional expenses that Spearhead covers including storage locker fees, post box rental, printing costs, community appreciation awards, continued trademark registration, and don't forget, website administration costs (an expense I'm not sure we were thinking too much about in March/April of 1998). In an attempt to contain printing, stationary and postage expenses, many Spearhead communications (including Phalia) are now distributed electronically.)

I'm not throwing stones at anyone but the last couple of functions were less than a resounding success. I think our future lies in smaller gatherings — someting along the lines of get-togethers that foster mutual respect and mutual appreciation. I don't propose to have a lot of ideas but obviously bigger is not always better. I think we've learned our lesson in the past. But where do we go from here?

2 cups of chopped white

Cook macaroni in boiling water for 5-7 minutes until tender but firm. Drain.




